### June - October 2025

#### • "THE BATTLE OF WATERLOO" - A re-launch of 15 mm Waterloo flag sets in a new format!

These sets are now presented in a stylish, glossy **A4 stapled booklet** to replace the 'loose sheets' format from before.



*What's included that's new?*

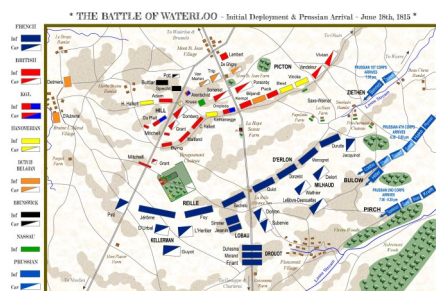
- **Flags are now printed on separate sheets** from the text. This means they can now be cut out freely without damaging the Orders of Battle info.
- **Improved flag designs** and historical accuracy.
- **Waterloo Battle Map.**
- **Orders of Battle** now include historical **portraits of generals.**

*Note: 10 mm booklets will follow in the same format (not yet available).*

### February - March 2026

#### • "100 DAYS WATERLOO CAMPAIGN" - Launch of NEW 15 mm Flag Set!

Presented in the new **A4 stapled booklet style**, this 30+page set is designed for wargamers and collectors who want flags for **ALL** the infantry and cavalry regiments from **ALL** armies that were present at the beginning of the campaign, i.e. including Wellington's troops posted at Hal/Tubize.



*What's included?*

- **Flags will be printed on separate sheets** from the text.
- **Improved flag designs** and historical accuracy.
- **Waterloo, Quatre Bras, Ligny & Wavre Battle Maps.**
- **Orders of Battle** include historical **portraits of generals.**

*Note: 13mm & 10mm booklets will follow in the same format.  
6mm will remain in loose sheet format.*

### Summer 2026

#### "THE BATTLE OF LEIPZIG" - My apologies, a complex project much delayed...

After the 'Waterloo' series, I wanted to produce flags to cover the majority of nations and states that fought in the Napoleonic Wars - and the "Battle of the Nations" (Leipzig) suited this task perfectly with regiments present from Austria, Russian, Poland, Bavaria, Saxony, Westphalia, Italy and Sweden. However the massive armies and huge number of regiments that fought, make it impractical to create a flag for every single regiment - and indeed, who actually requires flags for every single nation and for every regiment that fought at Leipzig? A task few mortals would undertake!

So the format for "Leipzig" will be different than for "Waterloo". For, whereas the Waterloo sets have a flag for every regiment that was present at the battle from every corps and division, **for Leipzig I'm considering creating flags only for specific corps and divisions**, particularly those that include the nations I want to cover.

I therefore expect to produce individual flag sets for: • France • Austria • Russia • Prussia/Sweden • German States • Poland/Italy. However, I may yet combine these differently, depending on feedback I receive. **So please, if you have an opinion** about how you would like these flags arranged, **please do share your thoughts** - they will be appreciated. **Just reply to this email!** I will however, confirm, that I won't be producing and selling single flag sheets for each nation (sorry).
